

From the Desk of Fr. Kevin,

Dear Parishioners.

Collection for the Church in Latin America and the Diocesan Mission in El Salvador January 27-28

Next week, we will take up the Collection for the Church in Latin America and our Diocesan Mission in El Salvador. For many in this region, a rising secular culture, difficult rural terrain, and a shortage of ministers all present obstacles to practicing the faith. Your support



of this collection provides lay leadership training, catechesis, priestly and religious formation, and other programs to share our Catholic faith with those who long to hear the Good News of Christ.

This collection is the main support for the two priests who work in the parishes served by our missionaries, Fr. Paul Schindler and Fr. John Ostrowski. The 60 years of service from Cleveland priests, religious and laity have been supported through this collection. Please be generous. There will be a second collection during the offertory for this purpose.

Human trafficking and the abuse of children and the vulnerable people are two serious violations of human dignity that demand urgent and comprehensive responses from the Church, governments, and human rights organizations. By working to heal the wounds of victims and their families, bring perpetrators to justice, and implement awareness and prevention programs, the Church is bringing hope and helping to end abuse and trafficking.



In Venezuela, an anti-trafficking project combining education, communication, training and cooperation among church leaders, civic leaders and human rights organizations used grants form the Collection to help with the human trafficking issues in the area. In Peru, the same kind of collaboration among agencies used grants to prevent the abuse of children and vulnerable people to address reported incidents of abuse.


