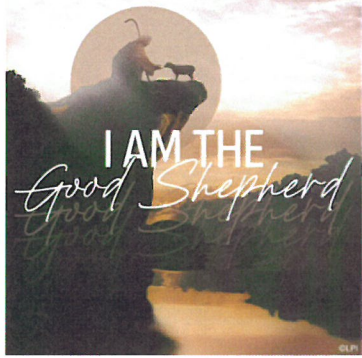

4th Sunday of Easter

Recently, I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me,

Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know Him and His willingness to die for us! This week He says, "I know my own and my own know me," and "I lay down my life for the sheep." Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down His life for you and me — and He has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and His saving love. This Easter season, the Risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about His love. He never ceases to lay down His life for us.

The Stone Rejected by the Builder

There are two major themes in this weekend's readings. Typically, the fourth Sunday of Easter is Good Shepherd Sunday, which is the major theme in the Gospel. The other readings however, pick up a different theme - that of Jesus as the Cornerstone.

The reference originates in Psalm 118 which Peter quotes in the Acts of the Apostles. Architecturally, there are two meanings of the phrase and it probably depends on the exact translation.

One interpretation calls Jesus the headstone or the capstone. Architects also call this a keystone and is placed at the top of an arch. The capstone is the final piece placed during construction and locks all the stones into position, allowing the arch to bear weight. This is also a great analogy for Jesus. In this case, however, He is the capstone of the Jewish people, the crowning piece that brings it all together.

Our English translation calls Jesus the cornerstone. A cornerstone is the first stone set in the construction of a foundation. If you're building a building out of stone, this is the first stone that is set, and all other stones will be set in reference to this stone, thus determining the position of the entire structure. This is a great analogy for Jesus as being the foundation on which the Church is built. We are the rest of the stones, and our position is relative to the cornerstone, Jesus.

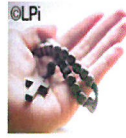
In either case, this stone is crucial to the structure and a builder putting together a structure would reserve the perfect stone to fit into this prominent fixture. Our Scripture verses refer to Jesus as rejected. The Passion narrative bears witness to the rejection, but the Resurrection announces Jesus as not rejected, but glorified by the Father to become the cornerstone or capstone of our faith.

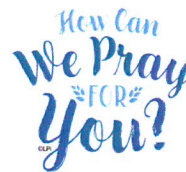

CONFIRMATION 2024

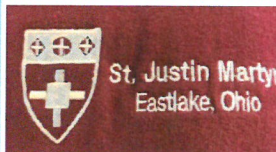


On Sunday, May 5, our Confirmation Class will be attending the 12:15pm Mass and then touring the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist.

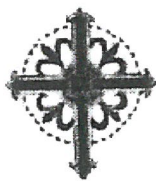
