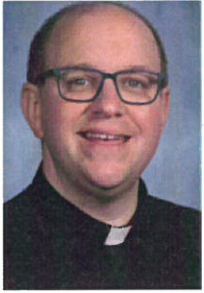

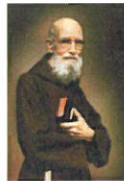


The new school year begins within weeks. Did you know two excellent Catholic elementary schools are in this area? Mater Dei Academy and All Saints

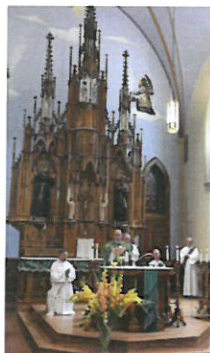

Serve Others in Humility

The pilgrimage bus trip to the Solanus Casey Center provided a profound opportunity for reflection, not just about Solanus Casey, but also about the Franciscans in general. If

your understanding of St. Francis and the Franciscans is limited to the October 4th pet blessing, there is a much greater depth for you to explore. Blessed Solanus Casey is a remarkable example of Franciscan spirituality, because he lived in our times and can be easily related to.



Born as Bernard Francis Casey to an Irish immigrant family in 1870 in Oak Grove, Wisconsin, Solanus grew up with a simple faith on what was then

the American frontier. He felt a calling to the priesthood, but struggled with schooling that was taught in German and Latin, two languages unfamiliar to the young farmer. Eventually, his persistence paid off, and he was ordained, taking the religious name Francis Solanus. Given his academic struggles, he was assigned the role of porter, which essentially meant he answered the door.

This humble position did not matter to Solanus. He was pleased to do God's work. As porter, he met nearly everyone who visited the St. Bonaventure Monastery in Detroit. Earning the recognition as "The Doorkeeper," he encountered thousands of people from all walks of life, always ready to listen and encourage them to "thank God ahead of time."



Blessed Solanus maintained his simple faith throughout his life. He took God's word to heart, believing that every prayer is answered in God's own way. The lesson from Blessed Solanus' life is the same as that taught by Saint Francis, both originating from Jesus: humble service to one another. Saint Francis and Blessed Solanus would be the first to tell you not to imitate them, but rather to imitate Jesus, who came not to be served, but to serve.

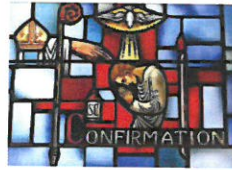

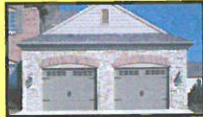
