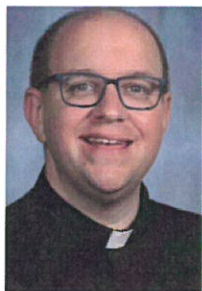

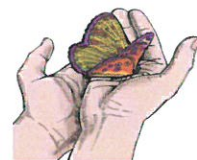

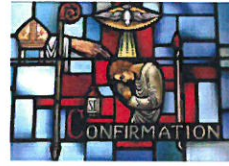

This ministry is completed at home. All supplies are given to you, stamps, cards and addresses.

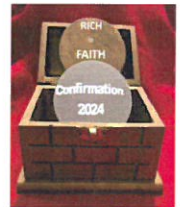
