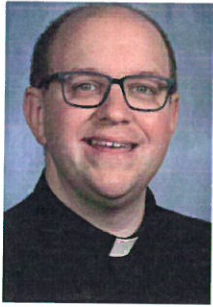

A Note From Our New Parish Administrator:



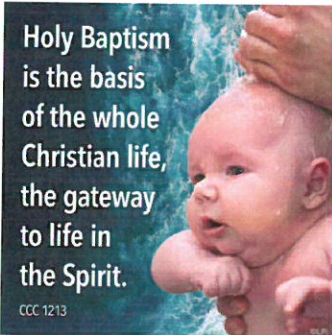

We will be collecting items here at St. Justin's the weekend of August 31/September 1 in the gallery.

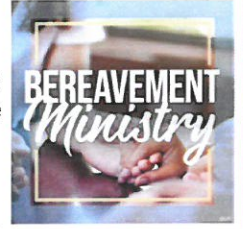

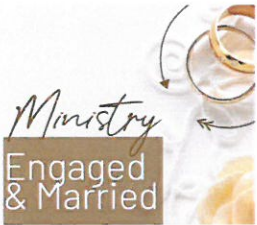
