Liturgical Ministers

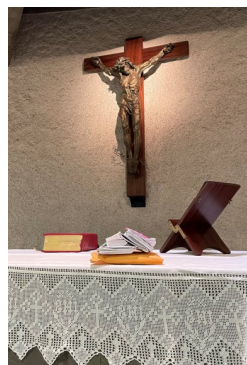

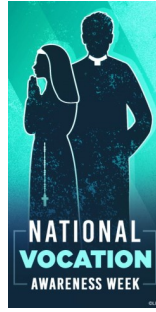

Catholic Social Teaching Month: 4 Weeks 4 the Common Good

Week 1: Dignity of the Human Person

The dignity of the human person is rooted in his creation in the image and likeness of God (CCC 1700). As such,...all men have the same nature and the same origin. Redeemed by the sacrifice of Christ, all are called to participate in the same divine beatitude: All therefore enjoy an equal dignity.” (CCC 1394)

This teaching on the dignity of each person is the starting point and foundation of all Catholic Social Teaching (CST). It means that every person is precious, that people are more important than things, and that we are to make every effort to respect that dignity and help each person to flourish. In 1986, the US Bishops wrote in Economic Justice for All, “As such, every human being possesses an inalienable dignity that stamps human existence prior to any division into races or nations and prior to human labor and achievement.”

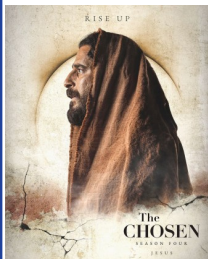

If we do not feed it with God, we will search to fill it with things of this world, which will never satisfy. So it becomes a question of life or death: "the human person has a need that is even more profound, a hunger that is more than one that bread can quench - hunger that has the human heart from the immensity of God. It is a hunger that can only be satisfied by Him who said: 'unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day' "(Jn 6: 53-55).—**Saint John Paul II**
